Notice of Intent - Fee Schedule

Purpose

The document sets forth a schedule of fees imposed by the Secured Party Creditor for any business dealings or interactions involving the specified entities. These fees are mandatory and must be paid before any business can commence. In the event of non-payment, the Secured Party Creditor reserves the right to refuse or void any business interactions.

Key Sections

Notification of Fees

Penalties and Additional Damages

Trespass by Public Officials or Officers: Various penalties ranging from R5,000 to R1,000,000 depending on the

offense.

Total Damages: Damages will be multiplied by three for punitive or additional damages.

Payment Terms

Invoice Due Date: Payment is due 15 days after the receipt of the invoice.

Payment Instructions: Details for where and how to make the payment.

Instructions for Completion

Fill in Blanks: The blanks for the names of the Secured Party Creditor and other entities must be completed

before finalizing the document.

Signature and Authorization: The Secured Party Creditor must sign and authorize the fee schedule.

Date and Location: Include the date and location of the document's execution.
